Dear Friend

It is with grand pleasure
I sit down to answer your
kind letter which I received
this evening and was
glad to hear from you
it is not decided yet
whether we will go yet
or not if we do we will
go soon if we go now
we will go to ~~Kent~~
Tennessee now we have
stayed here untill we
have lost our position
in St Louis so it is

doubtful yet whether we
will go or not and I don't
care whether we go or stay
as for my part they want
us to go without our pay
but we are not going to stop
without they pay us if
we leave the state without
our pay we will never get
any thing some don't
know as we will ever go
any further we have just
had news that one the
soldiers in the other camp
died very sudden since
I commenced to write he
was sitting by the table

when he fell dead he made
no complaints of being
unwell he was well as
usual as far as any one
know until he fell
dead write as soon as you
get this letter so it will
get here before we go
that is if we go we are
not gone yet I can't think
of much more to write
this at time give my
best respects to Eliza
and all the rest of the
folks my love to you
I guess that is all for
this time only some
