you an it is not over with

then my army will be on
the wing hatching and
killing traitors and bushwhac
ers an giving them their
doom since i last had a chance
to write home we have march
over 20050 miles going through
South Carolina and are now
quite a ways in North
Carolina we made old South
Carolina know what war was
i tell you we burnt every thing
we came to was that not write
while we ware marching in
South Carolina more fighting
with the 20 Corps our men
then we did with the rebs
