TOGETHER With all and singular, the hereditaments therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever of the said parties of the first part, either in Law or Equity, either in possession or expectancy, of in and to the above bargained Premises, with the said hereditaments and appurtenances.
