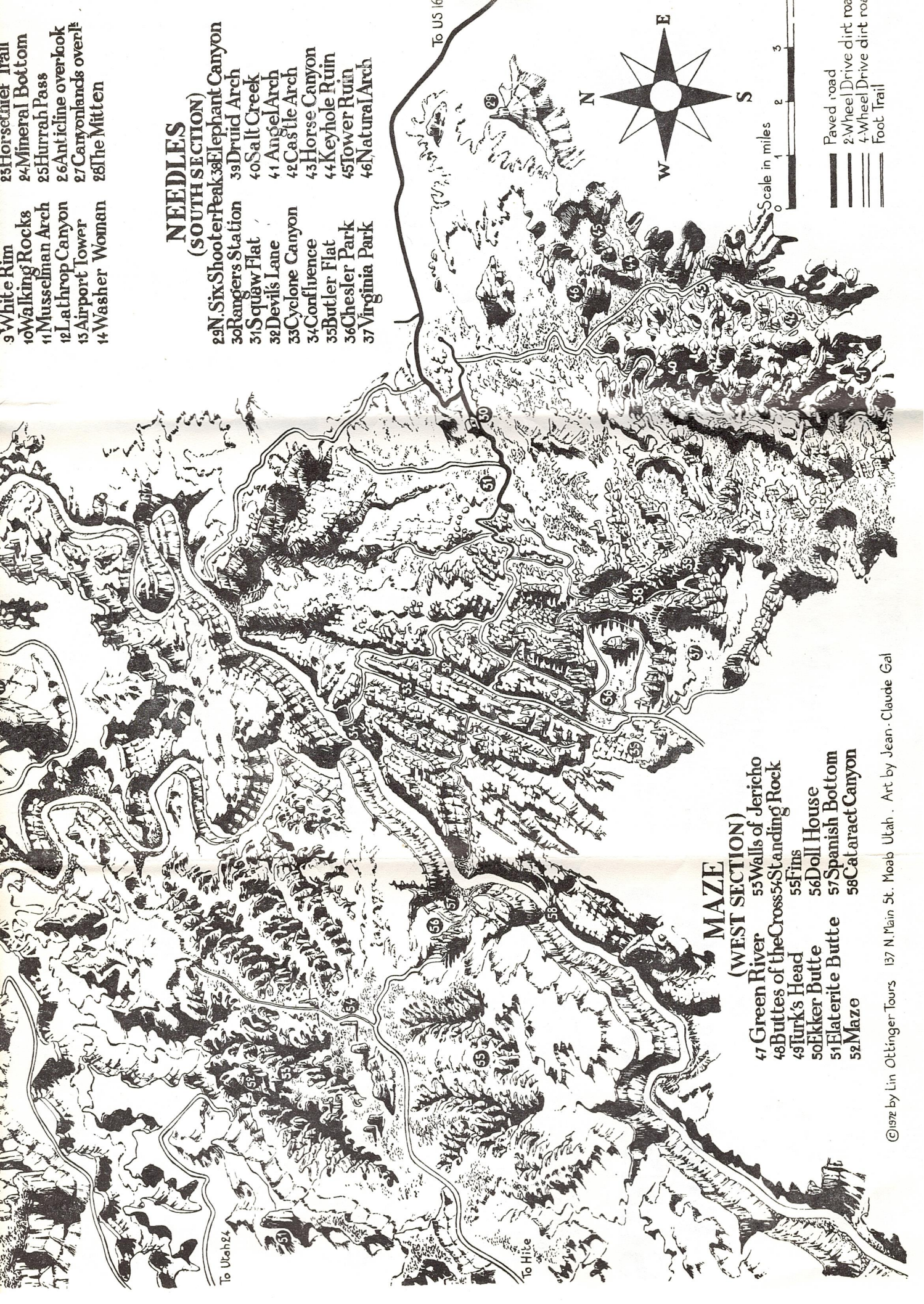

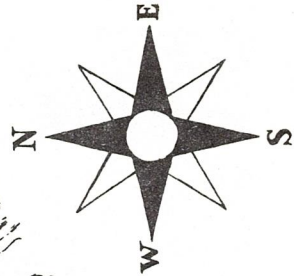

Note about the map on this brochure.

Canyonlands National Park encompasses a vast area, but is surrounded on all sides by country of astonishing beauty. The map encompasses most of the Park, plus some of the outstanding country adjacent to it. The park boundary is not shown because it has no meaning so far as scenic values are concerned.

Large unfolded 16"x22" stereographic maps by Jean Claude Gal are available of Canyonlands National Park, Arches National Park and Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park. These are ideal for framing or photographing. Maps are \$1 plus 50 cents postage each.

TOURS INTO CANYONLANDS

WALKING ROCKS

This White Rim Trip is the most popular one-day tour into Canyonlands National Park. We go down the west side of the Colorado River. You may photograph ancient Indian writings, dinosaur tracks, and natural stone arches, one of which you may walk across in complete safety, along the jeep trails below Dead Horse Point, up to the White Rim nearly 1000 feet above the Colorado River with the Island in the Sky still towering above us. We follow the White Rim to the Walking Rocks, a point made up of gigantic columns of mudstone, then up the famous Shafer Trail, (a loop trip) FULL DAY TOUR. See numbers 1-2-3-4-6-9-10-11 on map.

ISLAND IN THE SKY

This tour takes you over 2000 ft. above the Green and Colorado Rivers which wind below through the colorful Canyonlands. Near the center of the park, you stop at Grand View Point for a panoramic view of the Needles, Monument Basin, and the southern end of Canyonlands National Park. A stop at Dead Horse Point State Park is included. FULL DAY See numbers 5-7-8-16-17-18-19-20.

WASHERWOMAN

The thrills of the Shafer Trail start your day. At the bottom, you take the White Rim jeep trail to the Washerwoman. She towers over 1000 ft. above you, an unbelievable arch (14), then back the White Rim Trail to the trail below the Dead Horse Point, and up the west side of the Colorado River to Moab. See numbers 1-2-3-4-6-9-11-14. SPECIAL TOUR.

MONUMENT BASIN

Along the White Rim Trail to the Washerwoman, and on to Monument Basin and the

PORCUPINE RIM

East from Moab along the Sand Flats Road, past wild sandstone canyons to a view from Porcupine Rim of Castle Valley and Round Mountain. Into Cool aspen groves and return via Castle Valley and the Colorado River road. SPECIAL OR HALF DAY TOUR.

SEASONAL TOURS

In spring, see desert wild flowers in bloom (April, May and June), in summer to see mountain meadows ablaze with colorful flowers (July and August); in fall to see vast slopes covered with golden aspen, red oak, and other colorful shrubs (late September, early October) and in winter to view spectacular red sandstone canyons and spires overlaid with thin blankets of pure white snow (January and February). These tours are enjoyed by everyone but are of special interest to photographers and naturalists. SPECIAL, or HALF DAY.

DISCOVERY TOURS

Upon request, special tours can be arranged which take you into wild and seldom seen canyonlands areas which abound with unnamed arches, domes, pinnacles, caverns, petrified forests and scenic viewpoints. Some of these are:

GEOLOGY, FOSSIL AND ROCK HUNTING

Tours will be planned to fit your desires in these fields of interest. Mineral specimens may be taken along all tour routes except in National and State Parks. Aid in shipping specimens will be given if desired. HALF DAY or SPECIAL TOURS.

ARCHES NATIONAL PARK TOUR

Park Avenue, the Balanced Rock, the Windows, Delicate Arch, the Fiery Furnace, Devil's Garden and many other attractions, with time allowed for optional short hikes to the arches not accessible by the road. **HALF DAY TOUR.**

OTHER TOURS

GEMINI BRIDGES

The only known natural bridges of any size crossing the same canyon side by side, discovered and named by Lin Ottinger, can now be seen by you. Many surprises await you on this trip. Petrified wood, agate, arches, stone spires and deep canyons. **SPECIAL TOUR.** (Half Day-top of bridges only.)

HURRAH PASS

Down the Colorado River through Cane Creek Canyon and over Hurrah Pass into wild and spectacular canyonlands east of the Colorado River, past Chicken Corner and along Short Packoff Trail to the gooseneck below Dead Horse Point. **SPECIAL.** (HALF DAY trip to top of pass only.) See numbers 1-25, is across the river from 10.

ONION CREEK

Up the Colorado River to the Priest and Nuns, on up fantastic Onion Creek, by Sulfur Springs through a spectacular "gyp squeeze" with numerous scenic stops along the way. **SPECIAL.**

BACKPACKING

Hiking tours from one to eight days into areas not accessible by any other means. Find yourself and many other spectacular wonders of nature. Eat many natural foods of the canyonlands. Write for schedule or to be put on our hiker's list.
