David Belding Read, the only child of Ben C. Read (Benjamin) and Harriet Smith Read, died on July 11, 1950, at Sherwood, Wisconsin. David Belding Read left surviving him no widow, no children and no children of any deceased child.

Ben C. Read, a retired retail merchant, died October 20, 1921, at Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Harriet Smith Read died October 11, 1932, at Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

4. ANY SISTERS OR BROTHERS OR ANY ISSUE OF ANY SISTERS OR BROTHERS of both Hiram Smith and Vesta Olmstead Smith, who were the parents of Harriet Smith Read. (Hiram Smith, at one time president of a Neenah, Wisconsin, bank, died at Neenah, Wisconsin, on January 4, 1900. His widow, Vesta Olmstead Smith, died at Neenah, Wisconsin, on July 13, 1919.
