Sir..." The letter is short apologizing for not writing sooner, but he was waiting for a letter from E. M. Dick which never came. He states there are no particulars to write about and signs it "This is from your sincere friend, J. A. --- Esqr." the last name is missing because the paper has been cut. there is writing on the back in both pink and black. The pink reads "These colors reed a shot from a seige [sic] gun at the battle of Chicamanga" and the black ink is upside down and reads "Well Ed don't be surprised iff [sic] I come home with a pretty southern lady as man & woman".
