17. of Sept came safe to
hand finding me well and
heartly and I am still the same
and hope this may find you
enjoying the same

Well Edgar tho isent
much going on here only we
are gaining Victories all the while
and you of course will hear
of Grant late movements so
it will be of no use for me
to tell you but Sheridan
is whipping old Early still
up about Staunton and
I hope he will give him

all he wants before he can
get as far as Richmond
with his men but we gave them
a nice turn at the Wheel house
when we fought them here
at this place and now our
our Brigade is doing gam-
con duty here at Winchester
and we make out to have
a right smart time to
as the Ladies are mostly all
lcesh, but I hope those ones
of yours may all be caught
this time for now is the time
that they are wanted and if this
Halls Campaign don't close this
time then it won't in 10 years
but I hope you will try and
content yourself some way as
you say it is so lonesome
but I can amuse myself most
any time here now as we

had had our regular Green
Backs and now the money
was Flourish again nothing
but Gambling but I must
close with my compliments
to the Folks and accept a
Ration yourself and write
soon and Oblige
