

To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting,

WHEREAS, Orasmus J. Fowler ^{Assignee} of Calumet County has deposited in the office of the Clerk of the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Calumet in the State of Wisconsin, five certificates of the County Treasurer of said County, whereby it appears that the following described pieces or parcels of land lying and being situate in the County of Calumet to wit:

North half of Lot N^o twenty three (23) in the town of Manchester
 South half of Lot N^o twenty four (24) in the town of Manchester
 East half of Lot N^o eighty nine (89) in the town of Manchester
 East half of Lot N^o one hundred and ninety three (193) in the town of Manchester
 West half of Lot N^o two hundred and twelve (212) in the town of Manchester
 containing one hundred and fifty two 1/2 acres, be the same more or less

And for the non-payment of taxes sold by the said County Treasurer at Public Auction at Manchester in the County of Calumet on the twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty three to the said Calumet County for the sum of five Dollars and eighty-eight cents, in the whole, which sum was the amount of taxes assessed and due and unpaid on said five tracts of land, together with the costs and charges of such sale, due therewith at the time of making such sale, the whole of which sum of money has been paid by the aforesaid purchaser.

And Whereas, it further appears that the owners or claimants of said lands, have not redeemed from said sale the lands which were sold as aforesaid; and said lands are now unredeemed from such sale, whereby said described lands have become forfeited, and the said purchaser, his heirs or assigns are entitled to a conveyance thereof.

Now, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, That the county of Calumet in said State, and the State of Wisconsin, in consideration of said sum of money aforesaid and the premises, and in conformity to law, hath, and hereby doth give, grant and convey the said five tracts of land above described, together with the hereditaments and appurtenances to the said *Orsamus F. Fowler* and to his heirs and assigns, to their sole use and benefit forever.

Haussen* the Clerk of the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Calumet, have executed this deed pursuant to, and in virtue of the authority in me vested by the statutes of the State of Wisconsin, and for, and on behalf of the said State, and of the County of Calumet aforesaid, have herunto subscribed my name officially, and affixed the seal of the said Board of Supervisors at the *New Holstein*, in said county of Calumet this *Twenty Sixth* day of *February* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven
