BC2010.022.634B is the envelope that is addressed to "Mrs Louise Fowler, Chilton Wis, Rout 3 Box 138" and in different penmanship underneath the address "from Warren telling about Minnah dies". Written on the back of the envelope in Warren's hand "415 1/2 Lawe St., Rhinlander Wis, Warren Skeesuck".
