The letter lists the prisoners taken from his company. It appears the receiver and a fellow soldier were once in the same company as this man and he misses them. He ends by saying "Excuse my bad writing. Their is a great many Olds in this letter ha ha What." The way the writer writes, it looks like a poem rather than a correspondence: short sentences and short lines.
