In the bottom left corner of the fourth page is "A.S.F" presumably for Agnes Fowler. There is a stamp in the top left corner of the first page that reads "DONNER LAKE".

BC2010.022.597B is the envelope the letter came in. The stamp is missing, but there is a dark stain of residue left from the stamp glue. The envelope is addressed "Mrs. Agnes L. Fowler, Brothertown, Calumet, Co., Wis" and in a different penmanship and ink at the top of the envelope "From Jane Dec 9 1891 telling of her house".
