BC2010.022.515B is the envelope the letter was sent in. It is orange in color with a red 3 cent Washington stamp and "Martinsburgh, W.Va. Oct 10" postal stamp on the left side. It is addressed to "Mr. Edgar M. Dick, Brothertown, Calumet Co. Wis". There is a bullseye stamp over the 3 cent stamp. Letter was torn out of the right side of the envelope.
