Description Tintype of a young child. The child is being held by an adult male but all you see of the male is his arm across the child's chest and his shoulder. The child's hand also rests on its own chest just above the male hand. The tintype is glued to a piece of paper with a border that includes flourishes in each corner. Written in pencil above the tintype on the paper is "Millard F. Johnson". The tintype was stored in an envelope that reads "Millard Johnson #67". This is most likely O.E. Heller's organization system.
