In reply to your letter of March 20, 1950, you are advised that an uncertified photostatic copy of "A map of the lands called Brothertown surveyed in the months of July, August and September, 1795 in Oneida County" will cost \$1.00. A certified photostatic copy of the above map will cost \$2.00.

The only maps relative to the Stockbridge Indians on file in this office are as follows:

"Map of the southwest tract in New-Stockbridge, purchased by the State from the Stockbridge Indians on the 14th July, 1819. Surveyed by Chas. C. Broadhead, Deputy Surveyor, in June and July, 1819. (Madison County)" An uncertified photostatic copy of this map will cost \$.50. A certified photostatic copy will cost \$1.50.

"Map of the survey and allotment of the land ceded to the State by the Stockbridge Indians, in September, 1823. By Peleg Gifford, Deputy Surveyor. December, 1823. (Counties of Oneida and Madison)" An uncertified photostatic copy of this map will cost \$.50. A certified photostatic copy will cost \$1.50.
