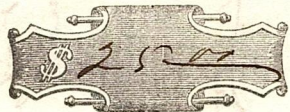

Bought of BLISS & ARMSTRONG, One Vermont

Marble Grave Stone; about *four* feet long, and proportionate width, to be delivered at

Brattleboro about the *first of June* next, unless some unforeseen occurrence pre-

vents, and then, as soon thereafter as may be; for which I agree to pay *Twenty five* *Dollars*

Stone to be finished as follows:

Usual top with square corners. Vines over name
in arc & over

With the following Inscription:

Amey Wife of Jacob Fowler Died Feb
10th 1862 A.C. 69 yrs 6 mos

as you are now so once was I
as I am now so you must be
prepare for death and follow me

Hannah (sick)
