along in the car. And how
we couldn't find Ted, and we
walked home, and when we
reached home we found Hattie
and Minnie there. Hell this
year I am all alone. No Aunt
Louise for company. Dad is

working nights yet. He is well
and quite fat for him. he
weighs 165 pounds. I am well
only lame at times, I hurt my
foot and ankle again late in
the fall. You remember that
old dead tree in the chicken
yard. I asked Dad to take
that limb off which was in
the way of the clothes line.
the clothes were always being
caught on it. And he didn't
so I got tired of washing pieces
~~over so I went and pulled it~~
down and it came down sooner
than I expected and I fell and
my foot went into the hole the
dog had dug. believe me it hurt
and me so lame it hurt to
walk for several weeks and it
does yet. It is not swollen
now like it was. We have no
snow yet. But lots of fog. it is

so foggy to-night the lights
look like stars. And yesterday
it poured all day and was so
dark we had to have lights
most all day. To-day we had
lights till 10 o'clock it is foggy
you couldn't see State Street
Bridge. Next week the Christ mas
celebration open up. There is a
big tree over by the R. Road track
on Main St. I can see it from
here. it is all lighted up.
Main St. is lighted with red
and green lights. Nina Mae
is in Detroit. She will be
home some time by Christmas.
Haller was up 2 weeks ago
Sunday. She is really quit
well for her she looks fleshy
says she is stinger than she
has been for years. She looks
it. She must be careful about
eating. Then she is alright

we have had 3 rooms ever
since July till 3 weeks ago.

One boy went to Hanksha
we have 2 others. They are very
nice boys. They have a radio in
their room. Now I have plenty
of noise. Sometimes good but
more often a lot of bad. We know
the river was frozen over for a
day or two but now is free again.
We have 11 chickens now.

You remember Mrs. Sam Sen
~~she was here on Sunday afternoon~~
She is in the hospital, paralyzed
from her hips down. Hasn't walked
for 6 months. 2 weeks ago the Dis.
operated her for cancer. Saw her
Tues. she is doing well. Looks fine
and hopes to be well again. But
it will be months before she can
walk. Regards to yourself and all
Write soon. Merry Christmas. Emma
