Dedicated in 1926, the Haskell Stadium was the first lighted stadium in the midwest. The Stadium Arch was built as a memorial to Indians who fought in World War I. 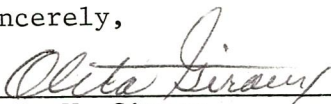
