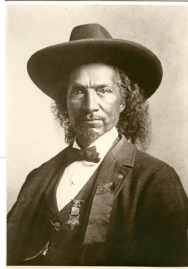

Sergt Stephan Wamsley Nicholas, "Steve Nick" A Full Blood Niantic Indian of the Narragansett Tribe. Co. D-1st Wisconsin Cavalry. Mustered in-Sept. 1, 1861. Mustered out-July 19,1865-Army of the Frontier. Wounded and prisoner at Hodges Ferry on the L'Augville River, Ark.
