Together with the fractions of lots assigned to the heads of Families for the benefit of its members". In the bottom right corner of this front page is signed "O.E. Heller, 1934". There are nine pages with two columns on each page listing names and lot numbers on each line (two per line with the two columns). Heller signed the last page March 18, 1935.
