There is an iron gate behind the smaller headstone belonging to Colwort, attached to a rock wall about knee high.

Written in black ink on the back is "Markers of Fanny and Colwert Pier. She died less than two years after she located at F.D.L." (I'm assuming this means Fond du Lac)
