

Red Wing Minn

April 9, 1893

"Father" :-

I received your letter and the money in due time. Am pleased to hear that every thing is going on all right in Bt. It must be more forward there than it is here, because when you wrote me about the snow being all gone, there was lots of it here then, but it is nearly all gone now, except in spots. The ice in the river started last Sunday, it is not all out of Lake Pepin yet. The weather has been very pleasant for the last week.

I am glad I did my studying last winter, because it seems

very hard to study this morn-
weather. I had to take things
somewhat easy this last, be-
cause when I would try to
study a while, every thing
would seem blank before me.

I suppose it is because I
have studied too hard. But I
guess I will be all right
next week.

But I must tell you
about the great time we
had in our parliamentary
law class. One side brought
up a motion and I opposed
it during the meeting, and
after we had adjourned, Prof.
Miller said he would give a
prize to the side that
came out ahead, at the next
meeting. The whole school was
so excited of the event that
they could do no studying during
the day. We have that class

Tuesdays and Thursdays after school is out in the afternoon (4:30) Well after the meeting was called to order it was found that the other side had thirteen and we only had eight.

But they did not carry their motion we kept them there until 7:00 P.M. and they gave it up as a bad job, so our side got the present, it was a picture of Prof Miller (about size) with a frame on it; as I was the leader it was given to me, I appreciate the present but I wanted to beat them because the leader on the other side thought he was so smart.
