Kind Friends

James and Herbert:

Since coming home I wrote

Mr Waters telling him as near as I could of what we tried
to do while at Brattestown to keep this work moving - of find-
ing different lists which would later be forwarded to him
by you - Giving him the names and addresses of Herbert Chiles.
James L. Fowler and Henry C. Fowler Yon-blu-lae - do not
know his street and number - I must say right here while I
think of it - that it is one of the Tribal laws - If a member
changes address after being enrolled they must notify Mr
Wright - New York - I mention it - because they have several
times asked me to do so. It is such neglect as that everything
that is the cause now of straightening the old list. Several
have changed addresses since their names were put on file.
It does seem as Henry was interested in this - was one of the officers
at E. B. Johnson's time there that he would be of much help now -
owning a car to go back and forth with - probably has plenty of time
on his hands - I have asked Mr Waters if he will please find
some one to go on with the work either living there or near.
Telling him that some one will have to go on with it -
instead of me. Am very sorry but for justice to myself I cannot
go any farther with it. I came away sooner than I would
because I was afraid I would get sick over there - I am

situated differently from you as nearly all of you own your
homes - I only have a temporary home with Edna and at my
age and state of health I am obliged to give up the work.
I shall keep in touch with them of course.
In looking over the papers after coming home and finding the
letter that had what we thought must be the Johnson list -
that Mr Waters was so anxious to get - when I wrote him
I enclosed it for him to read it - all the same as we
had the privilege of doing - asking him to return it that
I might send it to you to be replaced with other papers
I wrote him what course I took concerning addresses. like
in the case of different members of a family that had
changed - I wrote several different ones to have all
mail sent to one whom had a permanent home and for
that one to notify the rest. One like Grace Jaques she
could have her mail addressed in her daughter sure as she
does not own a home at Fort Huachuca. I wrote them Mr Waters that
I told the people that all money orders must be mailed to Mr Wright - Mr. C.
the head of the family doing the writing and each individual was
not obliged to write separately. just mention in the letter
whether the money was for dues which are \$1. per year or
for expense fund and to always enclose stamps - "which they
ask" and the parties will receive a prompt reply with
receipts enclosed. and now if you will let others read this
or tell them about forwarding dues to Lewis H. Wright New York City
New York. there will be no mistakes. please remind them that a copy
of Rules and Bylaws can be had for 15 cents per copy and annual report
of 1919 meeting for the asking.
