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- IX Power to sell good to pay fine
- X Any person not having the money or goods to pay the fine the Atty shall issue the necessary papers to the County sheriff who shall place the D of in good of said Co. shall keep him 30 days
- XI Keepers of Peace shall act as Highway commissioners to alter and lay out Highways, order repairs
- XII all male Indians <sup>18 21 & upwards</sup> are required to assemble together and hold town meeting at the school House in B. on the 1st Tues of April Senior keeper of the peace shall preside, shall elect, 1 Town clerk 2 Overseers of Poor, 2 Marshall and so many overseers of the highways as the majority shall think necessary, hold office 1 year May make rules, orders and reg. and bye laws as they think proper, for poor children fences roads fines etc
- XIII Authority to compel them to work on Highway
- XIV Marshall shall have the same power as a Constable in other towns, 1 Shilling for serving Summons, 2 " " " " an execution
- XV Division of land to Heirs
- XVI Atty or Commissioners to settle disputes concerning lands
- XVII Overseer of Poor shall be <sup>and Refuges</sup> guardians of children, who have no parents
- XVIII No Indian shall sell or spirituous liquors without license, Fine 3 Pds Keeper of Peace to collect,  $\frac{1}{2}$  to the benefit of Indians  $\frac{1}{2}$  to the " " " " poor
- XIX The Town Clerk shall receive proper Book and paper for his affairs
- XX Repeal of the 2 previous Treaty
