BC2010.022.055A is vertical and is a close-up of the headstone. Written in black ink on the back "Freewill Baptist Minister, came to Wis., 1846. Aug 3, 1934" in different ink "Union Cemetery at Brothertown, Wis." and on the bottom right corner "O.E. Heller".

BC2010.022.055BC are horizontal and further away, you can see the top of the headstone and the designed etched into it. You can also see more of the headstones behind this one. Neither has anything written on the back.
