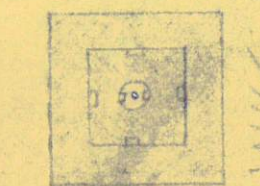

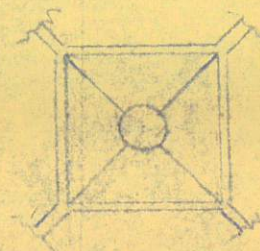

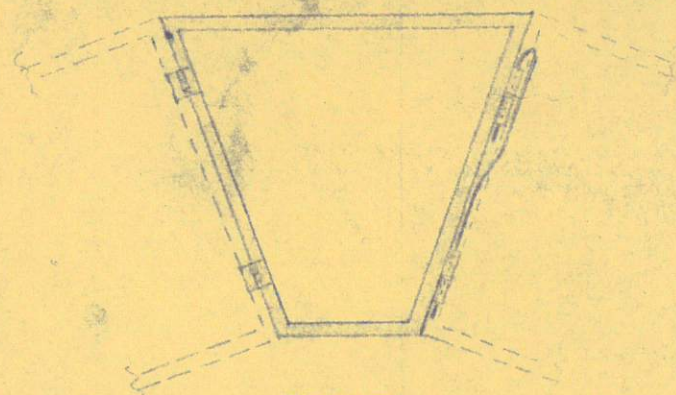

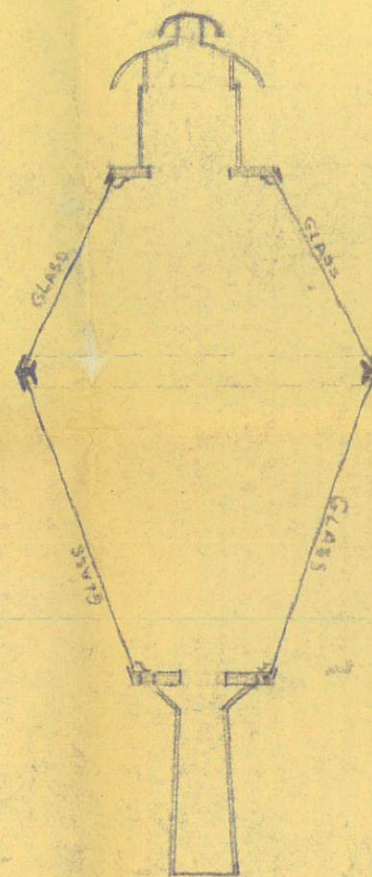
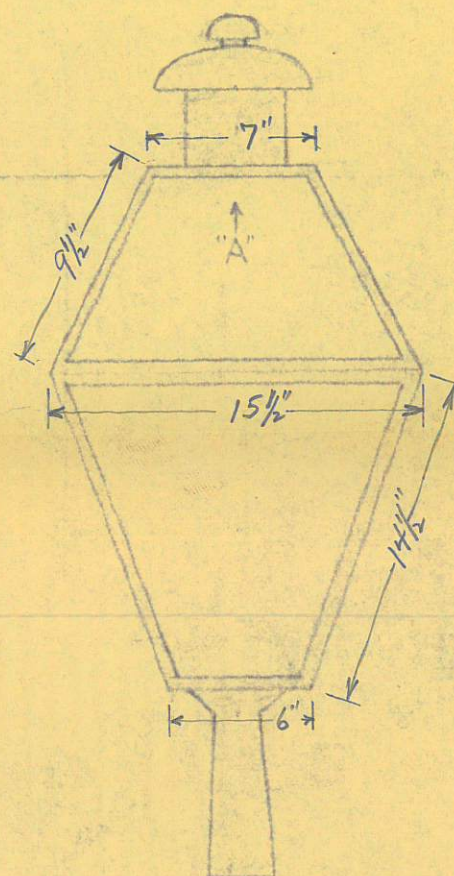

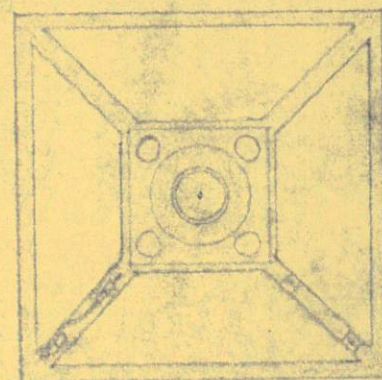
TOP VIEW OF CHIMNEY



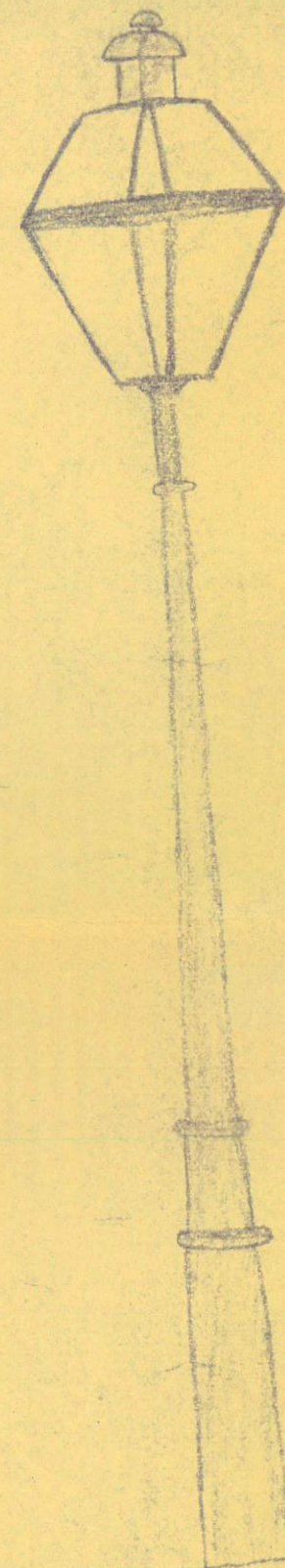
