

THOMAS YOUNG'S HOUSE. c1769 14 Water Street

Residence of Mr. And Mrs. W. W. Ball

It was known that Young was the builder of several houses in this neighborhood, including 35 Church and 30 Meeting Street. He also gave ~~the~~ ^{cross} at the ~~crossing~~ giving his name to a bridge that ~~for~~ time connected the two parts of Church

Vanderhorst Street over ~~the~~ Creek that was later buried under Water Street, but a small piece of mahogany in which was cut "T. Young 1769" ~~was~~ found built into the structure a few years ago obliging confirms the indication given by his purchase of this lot a few years before.
