

Broad St. Home Changes Hands

The purchase of the property at 100 Broad street by Mrs. Minnie S. Carr of 213 King street, from Mr. and Mrs. Lucian Nicar was announced today.

The transaction was handled by Mrs. Elizabeth L. Hanahan of the real estate firm of William M. Means.

Mrs. Carr, who owns the Commercial hotel, said that she planned extensive alterations to the interior of the four-story brick residence, but she would not change the exterior lines. The old slave house in the rear and the extensive yard also will be renovated and beautified.

The main building, or home, at 100 Broad street is 100 years or more old and is constructed of brick. The walls are 24 inches thick. The rooms vary in sizes, the principal living rooms however being commodious and with comparatively high ceilings.
