The top photo was the physiology-pharmacology building constructed in 1920 on the north edge of what was known as the Quadrangle. I believe it was on Mill Street.

The bottom photo is the main Medical College of the State of South Carolina building built in 1914 on Jonathan Lucas St., between Mill and Calhoun Streets. It is now the Hollings Cancer Center.
