Kevin said:

*"I'll drop these off this week. These three photos are not really all that remarkable, except for two things. First, they were taken by a tourist in December 1890. That is really early for personal, on-the-street photos. Second, the picture looking north along Meeting Street from Tradd Street is nice because the photographer just barely picked up the house at 60 Meeting Street at the NE corner. That is the house that was really Victorianized later. It always has a Santa's hat on the turret at Christmas and skeleton on the balconies at Halloween. The house began life as the mirror image twin of its other half (64 Tradd Street), but I've never seen a photo of the house before it was Victorianized."*
