Barbot Family

Anthony (also called Antoine) Barbot born 1785 in France married to C.F. A. Barbot.

(Marie) Cesarine Francoise Antoinette (C.F.A.) (Esnard) Barbot, born in Santo Domingo or in South Carolina?? Born in 1799, died 1880. Census says she was born in SC, but gravestone and other records say Santo Domingo. Aunts are from Santo Domingo.

Buys the house at 59 Meeting Street in 1853 (see plat from deed book).

Anthony dies by 1859 (probably 1855). C. Barbot listed as widow.

1822 City Directory is the first time Barbots appear in it: Anthony Barbot, Grocer, 81 Church St, cr. Tradd St.

1825 City Directory: Anthony Barbot, 85 Church St. Barbot & Esnard, Grocers, cr. Church and Tradd Sts

1829 City Directory: Anthony Barbot, Merchant, 55 E Bay St

1830 City Directory: Anthony Barbot, Merchant, 29 E Bay St

1835 City Directory: Anthony Barbot, Merchant, 53 E Bay St

1837-38 City Directory: Anthony Barbot, Merchant, 29 E Bay St






