This mystery photo from last week is 181 Gordon. It was built in 1940 for Israel and Ethel Altman. He founded the Altman Furniture Co. on King Street. In 1950, the front porch was enclosed and bumped out three feet. The photo shows the house under final construction with the original porch, so it must date to early 1940. They got the building permit in January 1940 and were living there later that same year. The couple lived in the house for more than 50 years! It is still owned by the children today.
