00:32:46	Mulberry Plantation laborers placing dead ducks onto a canoe
00:33:19	Two hunters walk by the garage at Mulberry Plantation and into the woods (where the stables are today)
00:33:58	More duck hunting and related scenes including views of a duck holding area; the laborer gathering ducks to release them into the water; Mr. Chapman and laborer releasing live ducks and decoys from a canoe; panoramic views of the rice fields; ducks in flight
00:42:57	Scenes of a train coming down the tracks and arriving at the Moncks Corner(?) train station; guests of the Chapmans leaving station by car; laborer driving a mule-drawn wagon on the Mulberry Plantation driveway; views of the woods; and guests arriving at the main house by car where they are greeted by the Chapmans and others
00:45:20	View of the front of the Mulberry Plantation main house from across the expansive yard; panoramic view of the main house (before the installation of the Loutrel Briggs garden), grounds, and kitchen garden

00:52:30	Two men walking on a footpath on the grounds
00:52:49	Views of the river and nearby grounds, grand oak tree, and laborer driving a mule-drawn wagon

00:55:28	Views of the Mulberry Plantation main house, footpath, grounds near river, pump house, boathouse, footbridge/boardwalk, stepped walkway to the river, and boathouse

01:04:20	Scenes with Mr. Chapman talking with a woman from a mule-drawn wagon, banding a duck, and duck hunting

01:06:11	View of the river and landscape taken from a swiftly moving boat
01:07:31	Panoramic view of the rear of the Mulberry Plantation main house and grounds
01:08:05	Views of a mule-drawn wagon near two Mulberry Plantation laborers working with shovels (Mrs. Chapman present); horse hitch and steps under a grand oak tree; view of the Mulberry Plantation main house
01:08:58	View of the river and landscape taken from a swiftly moving boat
