Subject: I'On L Rhett - Empress of Britain

Dear Valerie,

As I mentioned to you, I tripped over I'On L Rhett's entry on a passenger ship crossing the Atlantic - he was sailing on RMS Empress of Britain which left Britain on the 2nd September 1939 for Quebec (one day before the UK entered the Second World War, and a week before Canada entered the Second World War). I've attached an image from Ancestry.com of the immigration entry documentation which has his last address in London (I've double-checked and it is definitely I'On Rhett of the Aiken-Rhett House), and this is a link to the Wikipedia page from the RMS Empress of Britain [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/RMS_Empress_of_Britain_\(1930\)](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/RMS_Empress_of_Britain_(1930)). Let me know if you want a more formal citation for the immigration documentation.

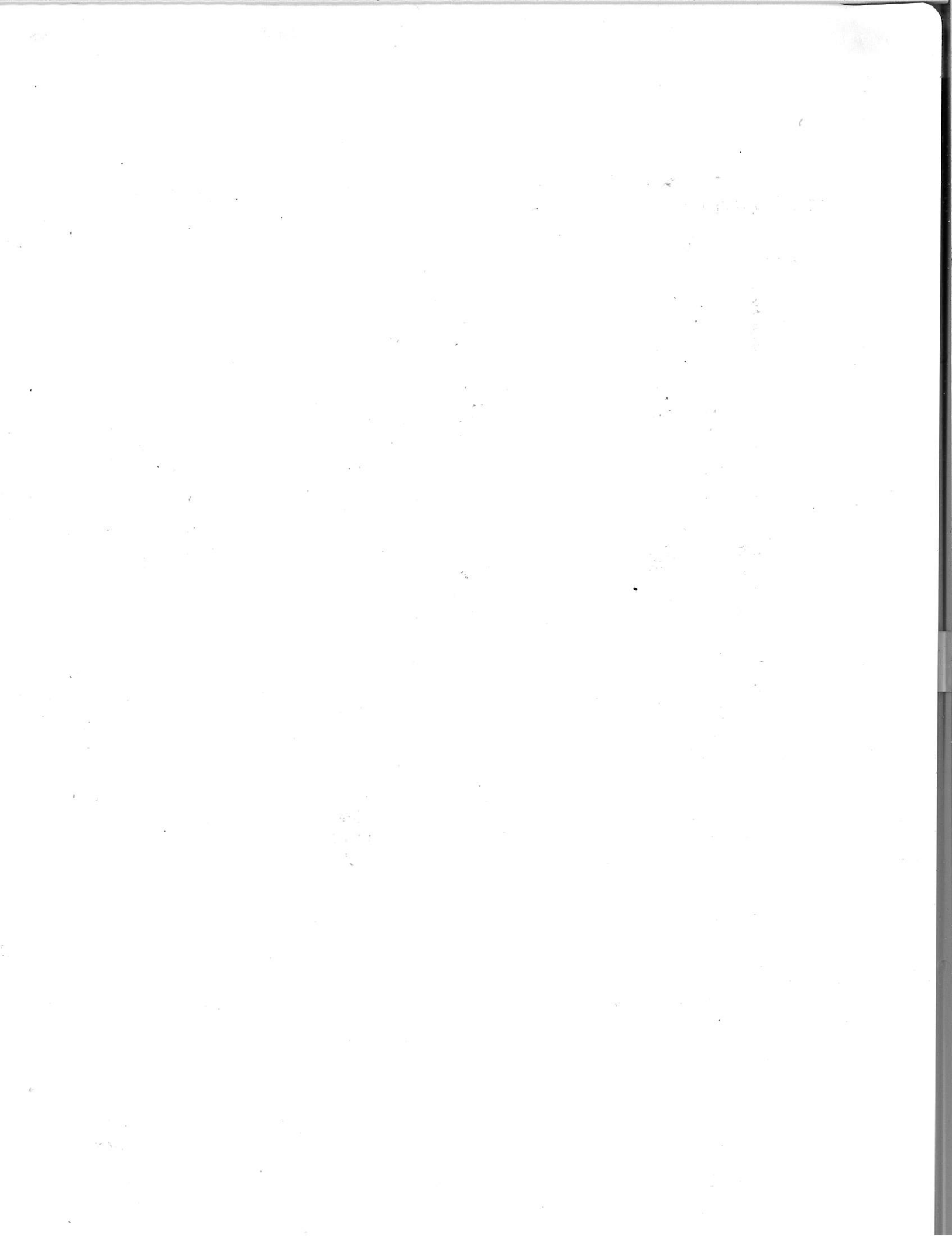
