ARCHEOLOGIST'S REPORT

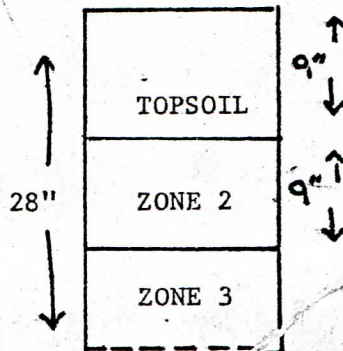
Nathaniel Russell House Garden-Landscaping January 27, 1982.
Done while new garden installation in progress by Jeff Parker, Bill Hunt and Linda Sloan.

We screened ½" spoil from trench parallel to south wall as well as a random sample of spoil from other trenches in the area cut into topsoil - GARDEN TRENCH SPOIL - 1 bag

TEST PIT #1

In order to determine if stratigraphy remains, a test square 2' x 2' was opened 39' east of the central circle of the new garden.

- BAGS - ZONE 1 - TOPSOIL - 1 bag
- ZONE 2 - DARK GREY LOAM - 1 bag
- ZONE 3 - GREY SAND WITH ORANGE SAND - 1 bag
