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Thanks for confusing me first thing in the morning!!

Ok, so according to their website, the offices/rectory are located at 89 Hasell and the church is 93 Hasell. However, when you call (which we did and are waiting for a call back for clarification) the message says it's located at 95 Hasell St. The TMS for the church is 93 Hasell.

We have a property record for 91 Hasell that states it's owned by the diocese, but was shop space that was leased out. The tax record says it's still in use by the Diocese, but I have no idea what it's being used for.

I have the former street addresses if you need that:

89 formerly 73

91 formerly 75

93 formerly 77 (although I have a plat from 1957 that lists it as 79 Hasell. Perhaps that why they address is sometimes 95 Hasell. As in it's 93-95 but used to be 77-79).

I'll get you more info when we get a call back from the parish secretary. Hopefully, she has more info.

Hope this helps and doesn't confuse you more.
