### **Sanborn Maps:**

The 1902 Sanborn map shows a 1-story dwelling situated on the north property line at the northeast corner of the lot. The shape of the structure indicates a small addition on the rear west side of the house. On the 1944 map, the 1-story structure has been moved back from the east property line and now has a 1-story porch on its south elevation. The back side of the house projects out further than the front of the house on the south elevation. It is not clear if this is a newly constructed structure, or if the entire house was moved; however, tax records and the appraisal both date this structure to the early 1900s. The 1951 Sanborn map shows the structure in the same configuration.

### **Additions / Alterations:**

HCF rehabilitated the house in 2000, as a part of their Neighborhood Impact Initiative (plans on file). According to the project plans, the HVAC system was to be specified by the owner and contractor, the air handler is located in the crawl space, and the condenser unit at west property line. The 1st floor ductwork is located in the crawl space with floor mounted registers.
