BOOKLET ON CHARLESTON

Splendid Souvenir is Issued by the Charleston Hotel

The souvenir booklet issued this year by Messrs. Riddock & Byrns, of the Charleston Hotel, surpasses anything of the kind ever issued in Charleston, both in artistic design, and completeness of description.

The brochure has covers of heavy stamped paper, of a fawn color, framing a tinted picture of the Charleston Hotel. The title page is stamped with the seal of Charleston in gold, and the title "Souvenir of Charleston, with the Compliments of Messrs. Riddock and Byrns, proprietors of the Charleston Hotel."

A brief description of the hotel follows, and then are reproduced eleven tinted views of prominent buildings and sights of Charleston. A terse, adequate summary of the tourist features of the city, and a historical sketch make up the rest of the printed matter.

The Custom House, the postoffice, the Pringle house, Magnolia-on-the-Ashley, a view of Magnolia cemetery, the Country Club, Fort Sumter, the Jasper monument, East Battery, Medical College, the Confederate monument at Magnolia cemetery and St. Michael's church make up the list of views, finished with exquisite colorings.
