St. Francis Will Build Nurses' Home

St. Francis Xavier Infirmary plans construction of a six-story nurses' home on property it owns at 148-150 Ashley avenue, according to an application filed with the board of adjustment, zoning ordinance.

The site is now a vacant lot at 148 Ashley and a large residence at 150 which was purchased some years ago to house student nurses. Others are quartered in another residence at 22 Bonnett street. The new structure will house the entire student body.

Although the estimated cost was not given, one source said it would cost approximately \$500,000.

The application filed in the city engineer's office gives the size of the lot as 112 feet in Ashley avenue,
