"Wheeler" - last name./

Dates include "1800" and "181-"

It is possible since the stones had been broken previously that these graves were disturbed in the 1950s when the full basement for 198 Ashley Avenue was dug. This seems not to have been part of the Paupers Graveyard (which was nearby), rather, it was probably a small family graveyard.
