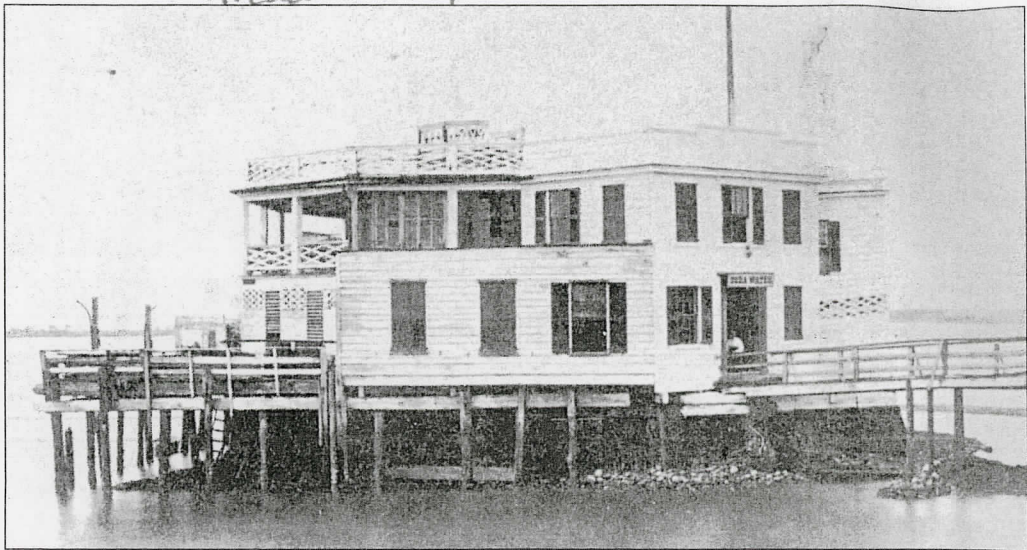


Chibbaro. South Carolina's Lowcountry

Appearing on maps as early as 1833, the building served as a Confederate lookout post and signal station during the Civil War. After several years as an eyesore, the structure was demolished in 1881.
