New Nurses Home Will Face Ashley Avenue

St. Francis Xavier Infirmary has purchased the property at the south-east corner of Ashley Avenue and Mill street to enlarge the site on which a \$500,000 nurses home will be erected.

The six-story home will be erected on the adjoining parcels—148 and 150 Ashley Avenue — and will face Ashley avenue.

The work of razing two private homes has been completed and the corner property is being used to house some of the nurses until the new building is finished.
