Enlarging Beaufain Street Drainage Facilities

Looking eastward, the picture above shows the work being done under a WPA project to improve drainage facilities at the west end of Beaufain street servicing a large section of that part of the city.

The drain pipe shown in the photograph is the old 14-inch pipe in which over a period of years has flowed the pumpage from the 17 Smith street and Lucas street stations. About 800 feet of the pipe is to be replaced, and next to it is to be laid a 12-inch drain. The latter is to be connected to the Smith street station and the old pipe to the Lucas street station. The double pipe will be laid in concrete. It will substantially improve the drainage in the entire area.
