About Perspectives on the Narrative: Telling a More Complete History of Charleston

Charleston has long been lauded for its history, charm and beauty. Yet, what is often omitted from the history books is the story of the enslaved people, their trials, tribulations and contributions to one of America's most beloved cities. A panel featuring former College of Charleston Professor Emeritus Bernard Powers, PhD and Acting Director of the International African American Museum; Joe McGill, founder of The Slave Dwelling Project and Shawn Halifax, head of public history at Charleston Country Parks and Recreation Commission, will discuss how Charleston's history became "white-washed," and the current efforts to balance the narrative going forward. This provocative panel will be moderated by historian Dr. Nic Butler from The Charleston County Public Library.

Through personal accounts, salon speakers interpret their life experiences in Charleston, looking at defining local events such as the Mother Emanuel AMEC tragedy, the building of the Crosstown connector, the integration of public schools, the effort to retain cultural identity in the wake of development and more. We intend to shine a light on the contributions of all Charlestonians, revealing commonalities and differences, while developing understanding and building a better future. Held virtually or in the historic Aiken-Rhett House Museum, these intimate (socially-distanced) gatherings of twenty (20) provide unique opportunities for enlightenment, illumination and connection with a diverse group of attendees. Audience members will include business, civic and social centers of influence, faith-based leaders, activists, students, historians and educators.
