## DANIEL LEGARE HOUSE, *circa 1760*

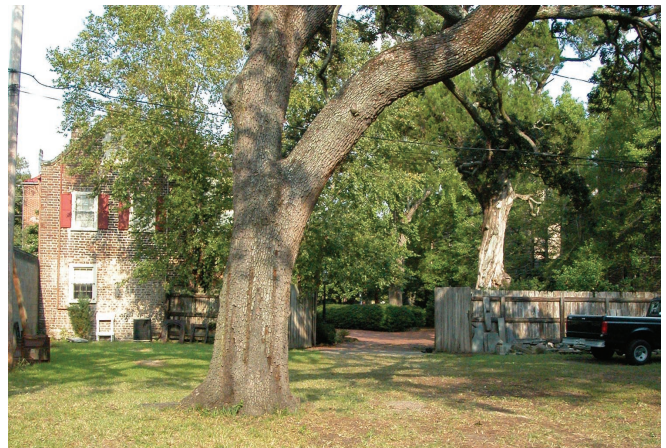
The building is considered to be one of the earliest surviving structures within the original Ansonborough suburb. This single family house with an existing dependency offers the option to build a guesthouse.
