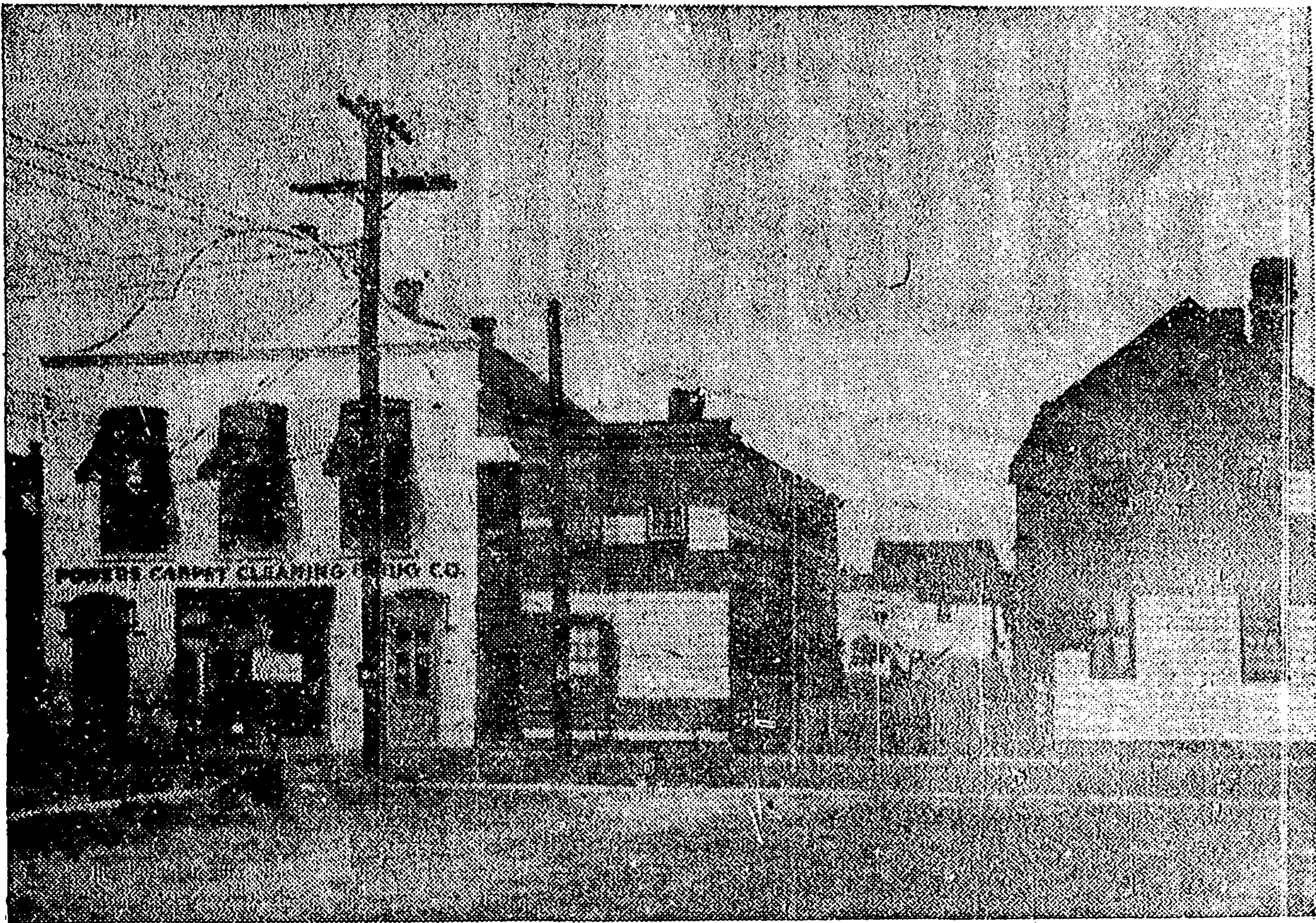

LANDMARK AND SLUMS TO GO—An old volunteer fire engine house at 41 Archdale St., now occupied by the Powers Carpet Cleaning and Rug Co., and tenement buildings at 41½ and 43 Archdale St., will be razed to clear a site for a municipally-owned parking lot. Removal of the fire engine house, which is directly opposite Market St., will make it possible to extend Market St. to connect with Beaufain St. to create a river-to-river thoroughfare. City Council Tuesday night appropriated \$23,500 to purchase the two sites. Another area to the south and west of the two sites already has been bought by the city. (Staff Photo by Reilly's.)
