So, here is the spreadsheet that I put together for the SC Dept of Transp. photos.

I was able to confidently identify all of the about 600 buildings. Whew. It involved scrolling in a carefully inspecting tiny details in houses in the background of photos and then using tiny visual clues like laundry hanging on a line to then figure out relationships to known houses in other photos. Painstaking! But, the result is really interesting.

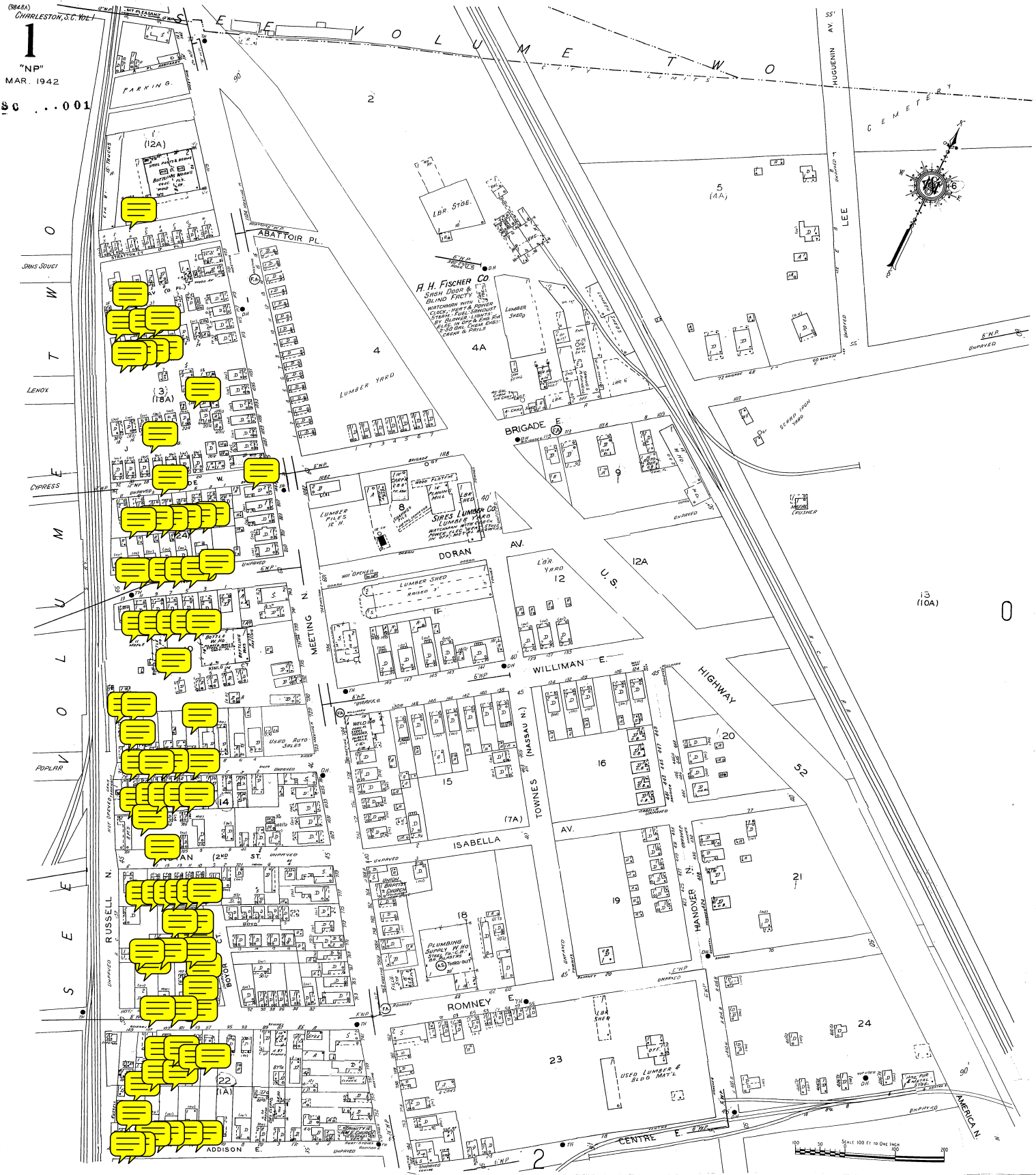
I didn't make any effort to figure out the 1600 buildings that were outside of the city limits, but someone might pursue that one day.

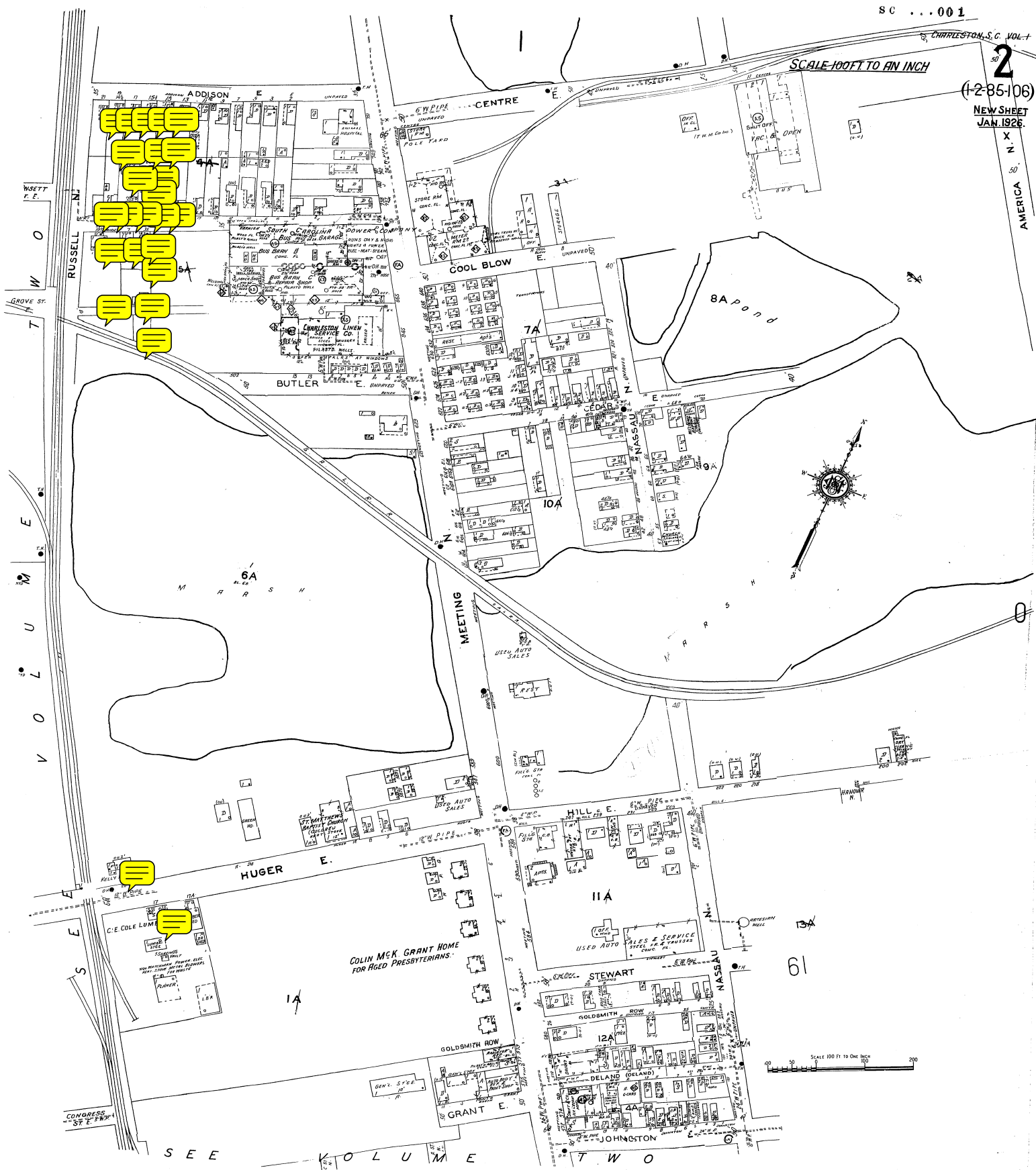
I used the 1951 Sanborn maps to pinpoint the buildings. Of course, between 1951 and 1963 there were changes. A few buildings were built and a few were altered or demolished. Still, using the property records and visual clues about neighboring houses allowed me to pinpoint those buildings.

I'm also going to send you the Sanborn maps that I annotated. By mapping where each photo was taken, I could figure out the path that the surveyors were walking. They actually took photos in a very particular pattern, walking up and down streets in a very regular fashion precisely one block at a time, one side of the street at a time. I added notes to the maps that correspond to the photo numbers. So, if someone wanted to research a particular block, he or she could open the map of that area and quickly see which buildings were photographed.

I'm anxious to hear whether that grad student comes up with the same thing. Having a second opinion could be a great confirmation, but I'm 100% positive about these, so maybe the student would be better off just saving her the time and sending this on to her.
