I took a few process photos of your Rosa frame in restoration when I was reviewing various studio projects last week. Please see attached.

At this stage, the ornaments are still disassembled from the frame and getting individual structural repairs. Meanwhile, our gilders have been stabilizing the gesso areas and begun to do some intermittent gilding. The next step will be to have a carver delicately remake any areas of lost punchwork.
