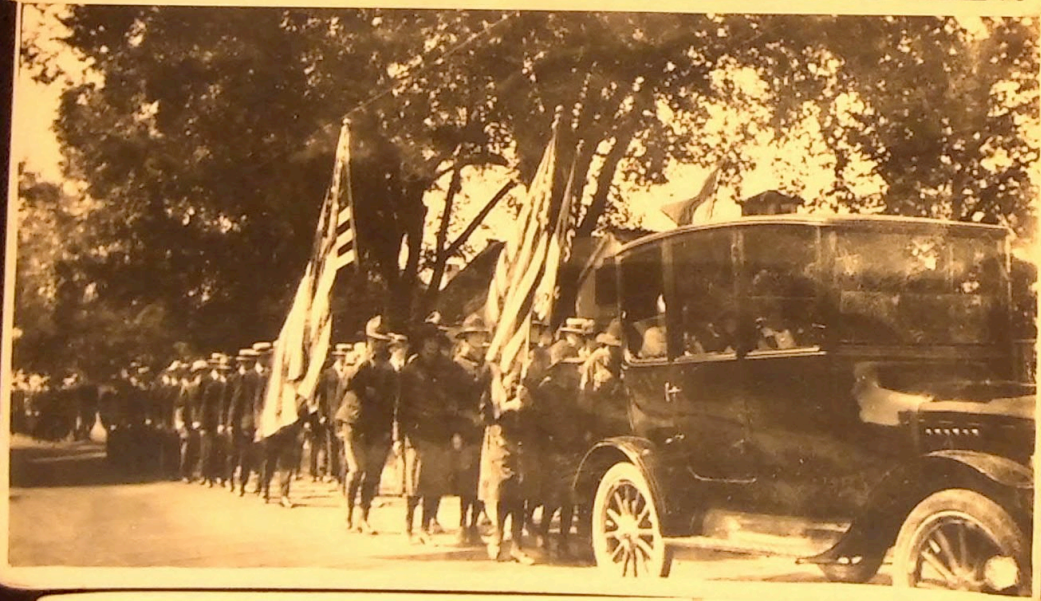
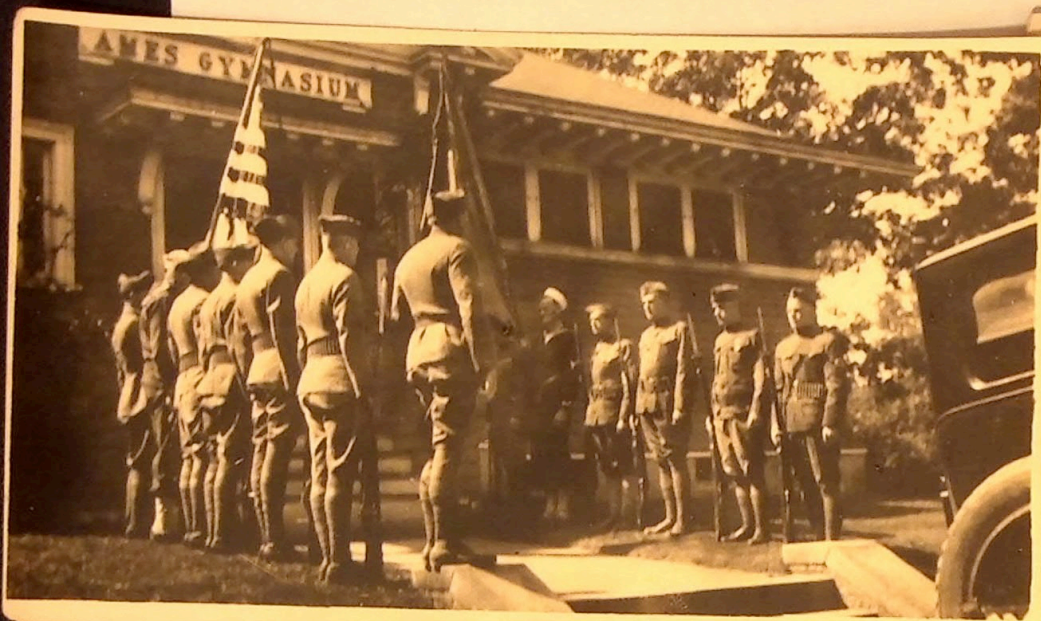


Pvt. George F. Schindler  
U. S. Army Infantry, Co. F, 104<sup>th</sup> Reg., 26<sup>th</sup> "Yankee" Div.  
American Expeditionary Force  
Killed in action in France on July 18<sup>th</sup>, 1918  
Only child of Joseph and Mary Schindler, he lived on  
Williams Street, near Jenny Lind Street.  
His body was returned to Easton in 1920, and he is  
buried in the Immaculate Conception Cemetery on  
Canton Street.
