Dr. George H. Miller 1919-2011

Miller taught history at Ripon College from 1954 until 1981. He joined the Ripon Historical Society in the mid-1960's and served on the Board of Directors and was a past president.

In 1964 he edited selected articles by Ripon historian, Samuel Pedrick, which were published into the book, A History of Ripon, Wisconsin. In 1990 he co-authored the book Ripon College: A History.

He played a major role in the Ripon Historical Society obtaining its three present buildings. He supervised the transfer of the Pedrick archive from Ripon College to the Ripon Historical Society. Miller also helped to plan the 1999 addition in order to have a climate controlled archives for these papers and others important to Ripon.

Miller spearheaded the nomination process to have the Ripon College Historic District and the Southwest Residential Historic District placed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Active in the Wisconsin State Historical Society Miller served on their Board of Directors and as President of the Board.
