in Herkimer, N.Y. into a family that was active in the Dutch Christian Reformed Church.

She and her two siblings, along with their parents, relocated to Ixonia, Wis., in 1845, where her father died only two months later. It left Helmer's mother a pioneer settler's widow in a town of approximately 120 people.

Helmer spent the balance of her childhood into young adulthood in Ixonia.


